For testing purposes the simplest test is: Swap out your C:\Windows\System32\rutils.dll file 1. Check what new things Windows Defender has noticed about your computer 2. Reinstall your rutils.dll 3. Reinstall Windows Defender. How can that rutils.dll (.Net) be used to detect changes to your computer? Is there some other database in the program that could do this instead? Would it be possible to compare two different versions of this rutils.dll, if there is a public database of some sort? A: I finally found an answer. The files are generated by adlay.exe in the Win32 etapi32.dll file. For example, I was running my tests on Windows 7 with the Office 2010 product key. I installed the Office 2010 beta and installed all the individual components (I tried to avoid the trial setups). Microsoft introduced nLets and nLets Usage Privileges that Microsoft has been tracking in a database. I had all the mandatory C:\Windows\system32\rutils.dll files installed. I had Office and other software that also tracked in this database (i.e. all the time and system logs). I generated the following files and then successfully installed the trial/production rutils.dll file. I then was able to verify all the information in the ~\Custom ba244e880a
