Associated Press Covington Catholic High School, a small, all-male Louisiana school full of teens and football players, was thrust into the national spotlight after an incident involving a group of black men wearing clothing associated with the Black Lives Matter movement. The incident occurred on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial on Jan. 18, when Nathan Phillips, a Native American activist, and the boys around him were surrounded by a group of about 200 African American demonstrators. According to the New York Times, the boys from Covington Catholic were on a school trip to Washington, D.C., when they were caught up in the demonstration. "It was the culmination of generations of racism and white supremacy and all that has built up over that. It was the culmination of America. That was the height of it," Ryan Carchidi, an editor for ESPN, told the New York Times. One of the black men who was involved in the confrontation gave Phillips a pepper spray canister and asked him to move out of the way. "The group of students that was gathered got out of line, and they approached a Native American veteran who was participating in the protest, Nathan Phillips," Nick Sandmann, a student at Covington Catholic, said in a statement provided to the Washington Post. "The student in question, who was attending a rally several blocks away from the area in which the incident occurred, approached the Indigenous Peoples March group." Boys ages 16 to 18 make up a third of Covington Catholic's student body, according to the school's website. Sandmann, who was wearing a red "Make America Great Again" cap, made headlines after a video of the incident surfaced online. He was widely criticized for appearing to block Phillips's face in the incident. This is a developing story. Check back here for updates.
