It believes the current system is outdated and leaves police and the courts with too much discretion in picking which laws to charge people with. But there are fears the change will send some people to jail who are innocent, and others to court where they do not belong. Lawyers, judges and police are all warning there is a danger the change could be applied too broadly and wind up "criminalising conduct that is not unlawful". The Commission's proposals would not apply in Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man or any other part of the UK, and will be decided on a case-by-case basis after consultation with the Government. But it suggests the courts should be given the option to treat "conduct which is neither a 'crime' nor a 'criminal offence' as a 'penalty offence', and to define a 'penalty offence' to include not only 'crime' but also 'civil liability'". 'Serious offences' Giving police the power to "authorise", or charge, a person who has committed an offence, rather than just detain them for questioning, would also be scrapped. Instead, the Commission is proposing "authorised persons" should be able to direct offenders to court, the Probation Service, a place of safety or community service or "to an appropriate body for an order to be made". The Commission says its proposal would "eliminate the need for the police to charge offences with a 'serious offence' label in the first instance", and the courts should have the power to treat "conduct which is neither a 'crime' nor a 'criminal offence' as a 'penalty offence', and to
