If you already have AutoCAD installed and running, the first thing you should do is quit AutoCAD. You may be asked to enter a license code to run AutoCAD again. If so, you will be required to enter your Autodesk account login information to use AutoCAD again. In this article, I'll assume you want to run AutoCAD without a license and you will be using AutoCAD without an Autodesk account. If you are using AutoCAD for the first time, the installation process will walk you through the setup process. If you are using AutoCAD for the first time on a new computer, make sure that your original installation media and the AutoCAD installation media are both installed. Check Your PC Hardware Before you install AutoCAD, you need to make sure that your PC meets the minimum system

---

requirements. The minimum system requirements for AutoCAD are summarized here. For the installation process, you need an installation disc or ISO file, which is contained in a CD-ROM or DVD-ROM drive. For the first time you're installing AutoCAD on a new computer, you'll need an original copy of AutoCAD, which will be burned onto a CD or DVD disc. For a serial number validation, you need your Autodesk Serial Number. The size of your hard disk drive should be at least 6 GB. When installing AutoCAD, the installation process will place the AutoCAD program on your hard disk drive. If you want to install AutoCAD in the wrong directory (usually C:\Program Files or C:\Program Files (x86)), be sure to choose a directory that is not already used on your PC. I will refer to the place on your hard disk drive where AutoCAD is installed as your AutoCAD directory. You can view the AutoCAD directory by opening a command prompt (Command Prompt from Start

menu in Windows XP) and entering "dir c:" without the quotes. Note that you can install AutoCAD to a different directory if you are using a previous version of AutoCAD. ## AutoCAD

Open the Autocad menu > Preferences > App Data > Click on Download. From your browser, navigate to the "download folder" where the software was saved. Browse to the "downloads" folder (or just search "downloads"). Open the "Autocad\_setup.exe" file. Select the "Autocad\_setup.exe" file in the "install" window and click on "Install". After the installation is completed, open the Autocad menu > Preferences > App Data > Click on Run. The software should appear in the Autocad menu (in the "Data Engine" menu). To see the toolbars, go to "View" -> "Command Bar" If you prefer to have the menus, go to "View" -> "Edit".

A: if you want to post data and not reload page, you need to use ajax's 'async: false' (boolean) (default: true) Boolean value indicating whether data should be sent asynchronously (with a XHR, a form submission, or a script tag). In jQuery 1.5+ when using the get(), post(), or ajaxSend() methods, setting async to false can also enable binary (blob) and traditional (array
